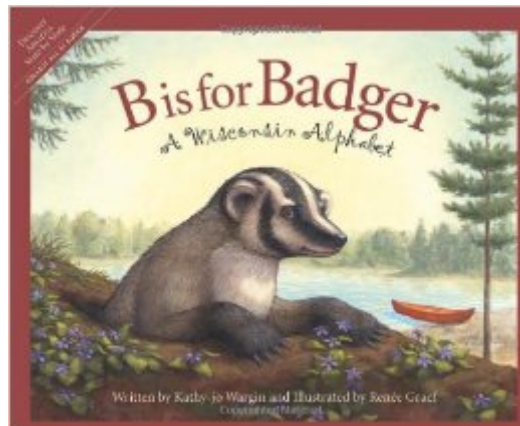

She lives with her family in Petoskey, Michigan. Renee Graef is new to the Sleeping Bear Press family but is very well known as a children's book illustrator for the American Girls collection with Pleasant Company. She has also illustrated for *Boyd's Bears* and is the illustrator of HarperCollin's *My First Little House* series. Renee attended the University of Wisconsin and the University of Madison; she lives in Milwaukee with her family.

"B is for Badger" is a wonderful book for learning about Wisconsin's traditions, history and culture. I'm a fan of this book series, but a few of the books I've purchased are quite detailed for young children. This book is entertaining and informative, though each page is short and sweet enough for the younger ears, but puts forth something for both adults and children to learn about. The illustrations are beautiful, and aptly capture the people, places, traditions and unique treasures found in Wisconsin.

What's not to love about this book? Its illustrations are lovely, the word choices for each letter are creative and, I think, comprehensively highlight the best Wisconsin has to offer.
