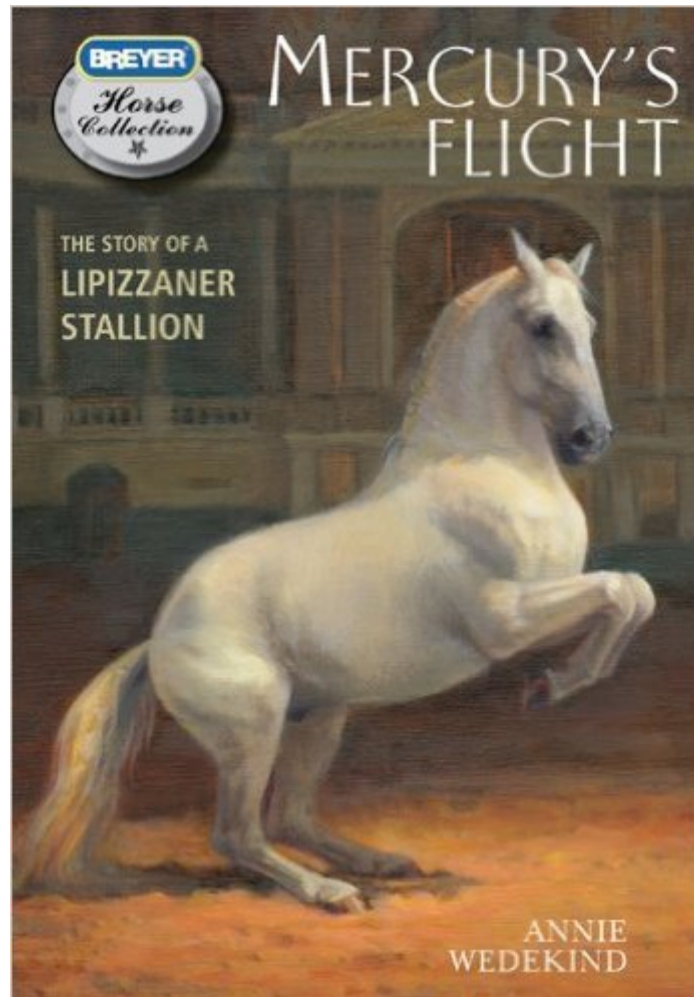

Annie Wedekind has proven her talent again in this beautifully written story. Narrated by the character, just like in Samirah's Ride, Mercury's Flight follows the story of Favory Mercurio, or "Schnecki", as he was sometimes called, from his early life at Piber with his step-mother to his later life after WWII. Though there were some fictionalized parts (Wedekind pointed out these in the Author's Note), there was the humor and exciting, dramatic story-telling familiar throughout all of Wedekind's books. There were also footnotes explaining about different events/real people mentioned and the Australian/German words used throughout the book. I thoroughly enjoyed this book and would highly recommend it. It is a close match to Marguerite Henry's "White Stallion of Lipizza," and another great installment in the Breyer Horse Collection.

Any horse crazy girl, or young women will love this book. It tells you a lot about Lippizanners history and training methods. A delightful book.
