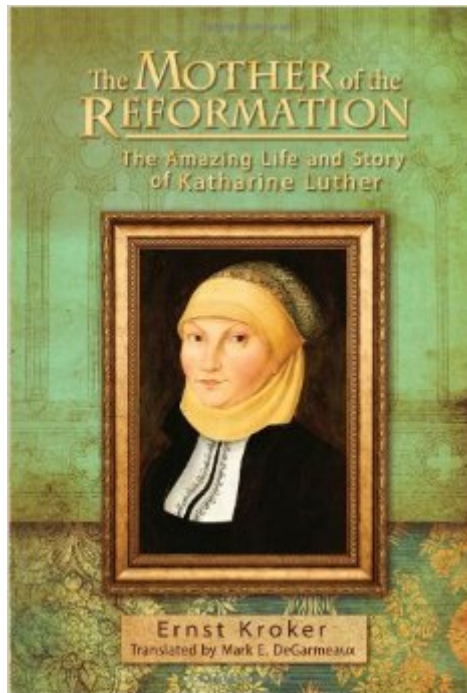

It provides detailed information about many of the people who played significant roles in the life of Katie and Doctor Luther. It is a solid foundational source on which to build a presentation.
